



Boys Home Featured at Southwestern Virginia Diocese Convention

a Note from Pastor anne:

Four students displayed courage and maturity as they spoke to several hundred participants at the Diocese of Southwestern Virginia's annual convention held in Roanoke, Virginia (January 27-29). Executive Director Chris Doyle kicked off the program by explaining the mission, vision and activities of Boys Home. Then students Chris Silvas, Sage Custalow, Rylee Callis and Mulu Slawta spoke about their life experiences and shared stories from their time at Boys Home. All four students spoke about their dislike of waking up early each morning, but many remarked about enjoying small class sizes, basketball teams and outdoor activities like fishing and hiking. Senior student Rylee spoke of his goal to become a welder in the shipyard, while Mulu said he hopes to attend college at Radford University.

Baptism and personally proclaiming Jesus were central themes at this year's convention. Boys Home students Amir Elliott, Nazayah Harmond, Brian Blankson-Mills, David Blankson-Mills and Kelvin Blankson-Mills were baptized in the celebratory Sunday service by Bishop Mark Bourlakas. Student Chris Silvas was confirmed into the Episcopal church by the bishop. These important steps in faith will be nurtured by continued chapel and discipleship opportunities on campus, allowing the students to grow in their faith in God.

While adults at the convention participated in the business of the church, over fifty teen attendees from all over the diocese had a youth retreat at St. John's Church. Five of the Boys Home young men joined in this program, along with Houseparent Thomas Dixon. Current students look forward to joining future events with youth in the diocese and hosting them at Boys Home.

Perhaps the biggest takeaway from the conference was the overwhelming power of God's presence at Boys Home. Young lives are being transformed and students are being called to grow closer to Christ. The conference was a wonderful platform to showcase the power of the Lord and the work He is completing in the students at Boys Home.
