



Shrove Tuesday Fun Returns and Ash Wednesday Festivities

a Note from Pastor anne:

The much-anticipated Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper at Emmanuel Episcopal Church in Covington, Virginia, has returned! For the past two years, the event was canceled due to pandemic restrictions. A group of students helped serve the dinner for all of the Boys Home student body and many from the local community. The festive evening included beads, decorations, pancakes, sausages and apples. Now that Reverend Katherine Doyle is the priest in charge at Emmanuel, the students at Boys Home attend every first Sunday of the month. They are fully incorporated into the worship as acolytes, chalice bearers and readers.

The Ash Wednesday service at Boys Home began outside the chapel with me burning palms for ashes. Reverend Doyle then had students holding posters stating "Alleluia" bring them forward for burial during the season of Lent. The traditional service included imposition of the ashes for all staff and students who wished, followed by Eucharist. I preached on the amazing depths of God's love. God offers Himself so fully with His own body and blood for those who come from and return to dust.

The voices of many of the students were captured in interviews on Ash Wednesday by Pattie Ames, Canon for Formation for the Diocese of Southwestern Virginia. The students offered their perspectives on when they first learned about God, how they seek to grow in faith and questions they still have regarding spiritual life. These interviews will be aired as part of the Lenten online series for the diocese. As we all seek to grow with God, I am excited to witness these young men offer their voices and see what lies ahead for this special season in Christian faith.
